TYPES OF CARE:

Residential – for those who are finding it difficult to cope at home.

Nursing – for those requiring clinical assistance and/or have Dementia.

Respite – temporary accommodation for a minimum of two weeks or more.

Facilities

Local amenities nearby: Situated in Corston Village with Post Office, shop and church within walking distance. The church holds regular social events for anyone who would wish to attend.

Public transport: Major bus stop within 5 minute walk.

Single occupancy rooms: With TV and call bell system.

Shared rooms: Shared rooms are available.

Washing facilities: All rooms are either en-suite, have vanity units or are close to bathrooms.

Communal areas: Bartelt Wing offers a front formal lounge – a Victorian styled room with high ceilings and bay windows. Day room which is light and airy with large windows and garden views. There is an additional small lounge on the top floor and a separate dining room. Gainsborough Wing offers several open seating areas in addition to a main lounge and dining room. All floors are accessible by lifts.

Garden: Beautiful gardens with a patio area around the house with views of the grounds, fish pond and apple orchard. Areas of the garden are secure.

Specialised equipment: Specially equipped bathrooms, wide doors, ramps, lifts, handrails and hoists.

Security/safety: Entrances and exits to building are coded.

Transport: A Cedar Care Mini Bus is used by all homes.

Services included in basic fees

Accommodation, light, heat, water and food.

Individual personal care and support, RNC is retained as nursing charges.

A personal television is provided in each Residents' room at no extra cost, unless a specific type or make is preferred.

Cooked breakfast is provided. Choice of menu for Lunch and Supper. Special diets or preferences are catered for.

Laundry: Including personal clothing, bedding and towels.

Activities and entertainment which vary according to residents' needs and interests. Range of activities can include: live music, sing-alongs, quizzes, games and arts and crafts.

Physiotherapy: Can be arranged through GP referral.

Appointments with visiting optician as and when needed.

Chiropodist visits every six to eight weeks.
